**Who we are:**

The main role of The Neurosciences Foundation [NSF] is to assist in the provision of funds for **research to help patients** suffering from conditions such as stroke, head injury, Parkinson's Disease, neuropsychiatric disorders (mood disorder, schizophrenia, dementia), MS and epilepsy. The Neurosciences Foundation welcomes applications for research funding from researchers in the West of Scotland.

**What we fund**

We support applications from junior investigators and pilot projects that could eventually lead to major funding. The Foundation is also interested to know in advance of any potential applications to be submitted over the next year and to discuss these with applicants.

**Levels of funding**

Contrary to popular belief, there is not a threshold of £10K, but 'value for money' will be a determinant. Applications above £10K will need significantly higher scores in our review process.

**How to apply and deadlines**

Grant applications must be submitted electronically, using the Word format application form available on our web site - <http://neurosciencesfoundation.org.uk/researchers.htm>. Completed forms should be returned to Liz Martin; email [elizabethc.martin26@gmail.com](mailto:elizabethc.martin26@gmail.com). 28th February 2015 is also the deadline for applications for PhD studentships. Details of this are on the studentship flier. The studentship application form should be used and applicants should provide details of the matched funding that they are confident of securing.
